Product Innovation Award 2024

SWIFIX: Leading products to enable fixing through EWI



n this issue of Building Update, we are delighted to showcase SWIFIX with our prestigious Production Innovation Award for the EWI sector.

Multi-award winner SWIFIX is synonymous with excellence and innovation and since inception in 2016 has seen astonishing year-on-year growth. With growth expected to more than double this year, Founder and Director Paul Brown has taken on a new company depot to expand the fulfilment side of the business.

The key milestones in the company's history include partnering with CityFibre to roll out UK-wide broadband with leading installation products such as fibre broadband cables, catenary wires and utility boxes. A further collaboration with Exeter College as consultant on curriculum saw the design and delivery of retrofit boot-camps and upskilling courses for the insulation sector.

Paul began his career as a plasterer working on the restoration of ornamental plasterwork before moving into the EWI sector over two decades ago and working with a company that is now a FTSE 250 listed company. Gaining working knowledge across the sector, Paul worked in a number of directorships delivering EWI, Decent Homes maintenance, gas and electrical and renewable services.

With expert knowledge of the EWI sector at large, specifically within the housing sector, Paul saw a niche market and started designing and producing a range of fittings, dedicated to refitting and installing lightweight and heavyweight items through EWI systems. With the legislative passing of PAS 2030 in 2017 and PAS 2035 in 2019, the industry has moved away from the more traditional usage of timber pattresses, which are now seen as poor practice by many experts including the Chief Construction Adviser (CCA) Peter Hansford. The traditional method of fixing items, such as satellite dishes, fence/gate posts, external pipe work, lights/alarms, canopies, utility boxes, through to washing lines and hanging baskets had been through timber pattresses, spreading the load over a larger area of surface wall. This however contributed to cold spots, thermal bridging and even impacted on insulation qualities, alongside the natural wear and tear of the timber itself.



The SWIFIX range is PAS 2035-compliant for retrofitting, modular housing sector and futureproofed for maintenance provision, meeting stringent requirements to mitigate against insulation compression, with its industry-leading watertight seal. The products include single universal fittings, satellite fitting kits, pipe connectors, connection point fittings, and tap fittings. CBeebies Rainbow Adventure: Bringing immersive theatrical experiences to retail

The CBeebies Rainbow Adventure opened a few weeks ago to great acclaim. The BBC children's channel has always been loved by children up and down the land, with generations of families tuning in for In the Night Garden or Bedtime Stories. The latest crop of popular hit characters include: Mr Tumble & Friends, Bluey, Hey Duggee and JaJo & Gran Gran and all four feature in the new CBeebies Rainbow Adventure.

Housed in the Westfield Shopping Centre in Shepherd's Bush, the immersive experience can be found on Level O, next to Next and is open to families with young children. The 55-minute theatrical extravaganza takes visitors through four interactive rooms with children invited to collect rainbow colours to complete the rainbow at the end. With exciting video imagery and props throughout, it's the perfect way to entertain children throughout a busy and tiring shopping day trip.

We were lucky enough to catch up with Sandpit Creations, an award-nominated creative workshop based in London and one of the teams involved in bringing the CBeebies Rainbow Adventure to life.

Sandpit Creations is on a mission to create innovative sets, props, and experiences that both engage audiences and are built to withstand interaction. The team of widely skilled creatives include carpenters, creative and concept designers, scenic artists, textiles specialists, creative technologists, prop makers, sculptors, and metalworkers as well as writers, directors and performers.

From modern and traditional fabrication techniques including joinery, fibreglassing, textural effects, microelectronics, and robotics, Sandpit Creations deliver next-level special effects and theatrical immersive experiences. Established in 2023, the award-winning team has already worked with high-profile clients like Samsung, Doc Martens, Aardman, Cupra, Kew Gardens and Wakehurst and completed projects in museums, attractions, bars and corporate events, with the dream team delivering perfect project management each time.

We caught up with Director Dan Barr to find out about this latest exciting project, "We worked on lots of different elements on this project: incorporating CBeebies archive video clips with set design and props, which was great as we got to work in a multidisciplinary way. In the Hey Duggee room, our brief was to design and make a traditional grandfather clock. Due to Building Regulations, we had to source fire-rated fire, which is not available from a standard Building Merchants and we had to use a specialist supplier. The clock features in an interactive 'disco scene' and the clock hands spin round, which was achieved by the clever insertion of an electric motor."

"Our creative team loved working on the carved butterfly installation, involving a rope pulley from the ceiling. The butterflies are all painted with beautiful, bright, striking colours, which makes all the children smile."

"The rainbow tool box is also made from fire-rated plywood and has toadstools and moss carved on to the toolboxes. It looks great and at the end, one of the CBeebies' actors pushes the button to create the illusion of a rainbow, incorporating the best in microelectronic programming."

"The immersive theatrical experience is a long-term installation and we will be on hand to visit the site and carry out necessary safety checks and repairs as necessary." "Immersive experiences are here to stay and are increasingly popular in the hospitality sector, especially bars and restaurants, leisure complexes, water parks, through to retail outlets and museums."

"We are a media-savvy generation, with younger people driving next-level technology, AI and robotics and immersive spaces add another layer of fun and enjoyment to public spaces."

"It's not an entirely new concept though: the Rainforest Cafe restaurant chain fashioned tropical rainforest ambiences across North/South America and the UK in the 1990's. Utilising plastic plants, fog machines, waterfalls and the enchanting sounds of the rainforests, the restaurants tried to emulate the 'first rainforest culinary experience.' Diners would be greeted by faux ancient ruins, suspended papier-mâché birds and butterflies and even a statue of Atlas. The chain experimented with animatronic animals and the centrepiece was the simulated night sky on the ceiling, accompanied by atmospheric thunders storms. Though rather rudimentary and crude by today's standards, this did set the wheels in motion and points to a captive audience dating over thirty years."



The Eco Clipper mowing system was originally developed to replace the cylinder mower in turfgrass production. The aim was to retain the cutting performance of a well-tuned cylinder mower, but not the high maintenance requirements and sensitivity to mowing conditions, such as wet grass and weeds.

The system

The smooth cutting decks with fast spinning small blades ensure a high quality of cut and a good distribution of clippings. Thanks to the electrically driven blades, the mower is very economical and quiet. The large wheels and smart mower deck linking system ensures good contour following and enables high mowing speeds.



The benefits

Users report high productivity gains and appreciate the low maintenance requirements and the ability to schedule mowing even under less favourable mowing conditions, such as early morning dew and wet autumn, which can often prevent removal of grass clippings.

The models

Municipalities and sports field and park managers have discovered the advantages of the Eco Clipper mowing system. For them, Eco Clipper now offers two versions: the 4.11m wide EC-FM4 Sport and the 3.43m wide EC-FM343. Both are positioned in front of the tractor, providing excellent visibility and comfort for the tractor driver.

The EC-FM4 Sport has four independent mowing decks, mows till 4.11m wide and folds up to 2.5m width. It only needs 50hp, but fits best to small size agricultural tractors. To meet the demand for more lightweight mowers suitable for most park tractors from 40hp upwards, the Eco Clipper FM343 has been developed. This three-part Eco Clipper front mower cuts 343cm wide and folds to a transport width of 170cm. As with the larger 411cm wide EC-FM4, electricity is provided by a PTO-powered generator behind the tractor.

Big benefits from small parts picking in pallet racking

Edward Hutchison, Managing Director of BITO Storage Systems, explains how using pallet racking for small parts storage turns this ubiquitous storage product into a flexible order picking solution.

While constant innovation generates a stream of new intralogistics solutions, 'classic' pallet racking remains the most

commonly used storage system. Its relatively low investment costs and flexibility – whether through changing rack configuration, retrofitting special purpose modules or adding extra bays – have made it an indispensable framework for storage and order picking systems.

Of course, many operations use pallet racking as the basis for straightforward storage and retrieval of full pallets, either to fulfil customer orders or as a bulk store for replenishment. But the trend toward shorter product life cycles is increasing SKU numbers. The drive to minimise stock



levels for each SKU and improve picking process efficiency to speed up order fulfilment, combined with demands for Justin-Time delivery and online retail, is generating a greater need for small parts storage.

This is where the adaptability of pallet racking comes to the



fore because small parts picking can be easily integrated within pallet racks. One option is to create small parts pick locations on the reachable ground level, with upper storage levels serving as a buffer store for replenishment. Small parts storage containers will help to store and organise small goods and C-parts – making them available for

quick and easy picking.

This will result in a reasonably efficient picking process but ground floor locations within a pallet rack will, of course, be limited. Solutions are therefore required to maximise the available space to create a pick face with sufficient locations for the required SKUs, and enough stock to ensure availability during picks.

Flow shelves can be easily installed into pallet racking to increase the number of pick locations and volume of SKUs located on the ground level pick face. Goods are easily accessible from the front of the racking – the rollers on the flow shelves allow bins and containers containing small items to be picked roll smoothly to the front of the shelf – which makes picking easy. A full container of parts will roll to the operator each time the empty one at the front removed.

Standard shelving is another option to create flexible small item pick faces within pallet racking. There are several solutions: the first incorporates static shelving at right angles to the racking, with space in between each run to facilitate picking. An alternative option is pull-out mobile shelving that maximises the available space under the racking – though movement of





shelving has a negative impact on pick time. A third solution involves static shelving parallel to racking, which makes front items easy to pick. Shelving dividers can be fitted.

Inclined supply shelving within a pallet racking bay will make items clearly visible for picking. Cardboard cartons or plastic bins can be used, though the later option enables preparation in advance at the goods-in area by filling the plastic bin with the items to be picked.

Plastic bins and containers will keep goods protected throughout the intralogistics process and during transport to ensure the quality of products are delivered to the customer in prime condition. It is worth seeking out storage system suppliers that in addition to offering racking, shelving and in flow lanes, also provide a container range comprising a variety of sizes with and a broad choice of accessories. Such a supplier will be able to design the optimum system to fit a given space, maximise the potential for small parts picking and, ultimately, improve fulfilment.

With all eyes on optimised fire safety, Pandor can manufacture customised fire doors, in accordance with FD30, 60, 90 or 120 certifications.

"Our fire doors can be laminated, painted or decoratively veneered and our acoustic doors can also be fire rated. The acoustic door ratings are certified based on how well the sound is contained in the door itself. The doors are tested to different decibel (dB) levels, dependant on the end location, with the higher the acoustic rating, namely the louder the sound it can contain. For example, the acoustic rating for doors in residential flats is 29dB, raising to 30dB in a typical school classroom."

"We supply fire-rated panelling if required, in stock and cut sizes, with a choice of veneer, laminate or paint finishes. Finally, our door frames are manufactured to customised order, with clear or paint finishes," added Mike.
